Beaches, Boreens and tales of Grace O'Malley, Ireland's Pirate Queen.

Following a gentle route, this beautiful easy-moderate guided walk often close to the coast with panorama views of the Twelve bens, Maumturks and even as far as Mweelrea, the highest mountain in Connaught.

A magnificent view of the ruined 18th century MacGogean Castle, which has direct links through marriage to Grace O'Malley. (Irelands Pirate Queen). Continuing down the boreen to the sand dunes, passing Connemara ponies and donkeys grazing on the grass. Returning along the magnificent shoreline - swim or paddle in the crystal clear water of Mannin Bay.

Explore the nature and all the shoreline has to offer, at low tide you will discover the bright purple mussels clinging pink rocks and shells under foot before making a gentle return to The Connemara Sands Hotel.
